SCHOOL BOARD ELECTIONS

The Lakes International community is currently seeking interested candidates for positions on the School Board. The term of office will be for two years, from July 2010–July 2012.

To find more information about qualifications and the election timeline, as well as an application, go to the LILA front office or look online, under the About Us/Board of Directors section of the LILA website. Application deadline is Monday, February 1.

Four 2- year board seats will open, 2 teacher seats, 1 parent seat, and one community member seat. In addition, one 15-month parent seat is open to fill the seat vacated by the resignation of Christine Thomas.



Christine Thomas Resigns from LILA School Board

Ms. Thomas' resignation was accepted at the December school board meeting. With the new charter school legislation, new conflict of interest guidance has been published by the state. As an employee of Patriot bank, with whom LILA does business, Ms. Thomas has chosen to step down from her board position to avoid even the appearance of a conflict.

Ms. Thomas was appointed to an *ex officio*, non-voting position on the board through June 30, 2011. The last 15 months of her two-year term will be filled during LILA's regular March elections.
