PAJAMA DAY!

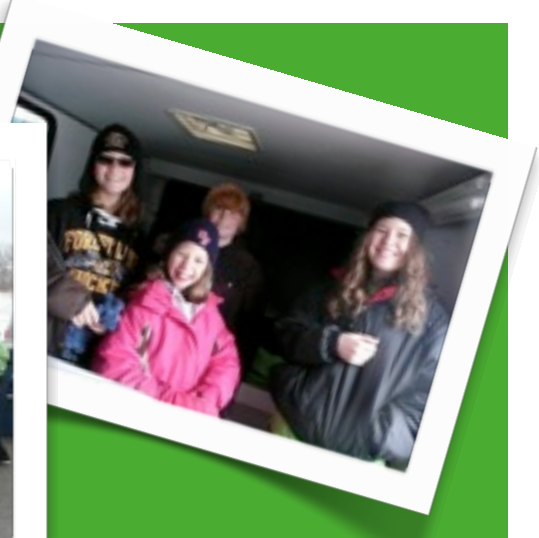
Hello Parents,

Our summer courses are offered in English, as well as Spanish, Chinese and Japanese. Again, in bringing Forest Lake the best in language learning, we will be hosting immersion language camps at LILA designed and delivered by the most extensive language and culture education program in the United States, Concordia Language Villages.

LILA Summer Academy is a fun and exciting way to:

- get immersed in a range of academic enrichment, language, fine and performing arts, and athletic programs.
- be inspired and engaged in learning by LILA's exceptional teaching staff and fantastic summer guest instructors.
- share LILA with your friends! Summer Academy classes ARE open to the public.

LILA Summer Academy is offered the weeks of July 11-15, July 18-22 and July 25-29. The Academy day runs 9-3:35. Course length is 90 minutes or 180 minutes (two periods), depending on the course:

- Morning classes run 9-10:30 and 10:35-12:05
- Lunch time is 12:05-12:30 (lunch is not provided)
- Afternoon classes run 12:30-2:00 and 2:05-3:35

Parents/students can make up to 2 choices for AM and up to 2 choices for PM (if the courses are 90 minutes). Each 90-minute course costs \$75.00 and a 180-minute course costs \$150.00. The CLV language classes are

- A registrant can register for 1 to 4 classes in a one-week period. A registrant may register for all three weeks.
- Students staying over lunch will be supervised and escorted to their afternoon classes. Students who arrive early to Amigos in the morning will be escorted by Summer Academy staff to their 9am class.
- Students staying over lunch must bring a sack lunch. School lunch will not be offered this summer. Students will be supervised over lunch and led to afternoon classes, or Amigos, as requested.

Please keep in mind that Summer Academy is not a replacement to ISD #831 Summer School.

KINDER SUMMER BOOST

LILA Kinder Summer Boost (*by recommendation only; for LILA students entering 1st grade who need a little “boost” before next fall*), covers language arts and math and will be offered:

- July 11-July 15
- July 18-July 22
- July 25-July 29

Summer Boost, led by LILA Kinder teachers, Srta. Katie, Srta. Claudia, and Srta. Chelsea, is intended for students who could benefit from at least one of the following:

- Continued support in Spanish Language Arts
- Continued support in Math (in Spanish)
- Continued practice in listening and speaking Spanish

Summer Boost is offered at the same cost as Summer Academy. The cost of Summer Boost is \$150 for 180 minutes (2 periods) per day from 9-12, 5 days a week. Scholarships will be made available on an as needed/as available basis.

Results from last year’s first Kinder Summer Boost class were positive. Help your 1st grader get a running start with extra help this summer!

Course Descriptions (in alphabetical order)

- Adventures in Sports** Explore a wide variety of sports and physical activities while focusing on teamwork, communication, and trying new activities! - Amazing Art** This class will combine literature and art! We'll read about famous artists, such as Picasso, in a read aloud format and share what we observe and learn. We'll also use the styles and techniques of artists we study to create our own projects! *Delivered in Spanish by LILA teacher, Brita Larson. Offered to grades 2-4 the week of July 11.*
- Chess Club** Summer Chess Club is designed to help players of all levels develop chess skills, expand knowledge of the game, and gain greater confidence as players. Throughout the week, players will review game basics, including rules, terminology, and etiquette, while also working towards mastering opening principles and developing end game strategies. *Delivered in English by the Twin Cities Chess Club. Offered all three weeks from 9:00 am -12:05 pm.*
- Club de lectura del verano** The reading club, that is! Are you tired of reading by yourself all summer? 


